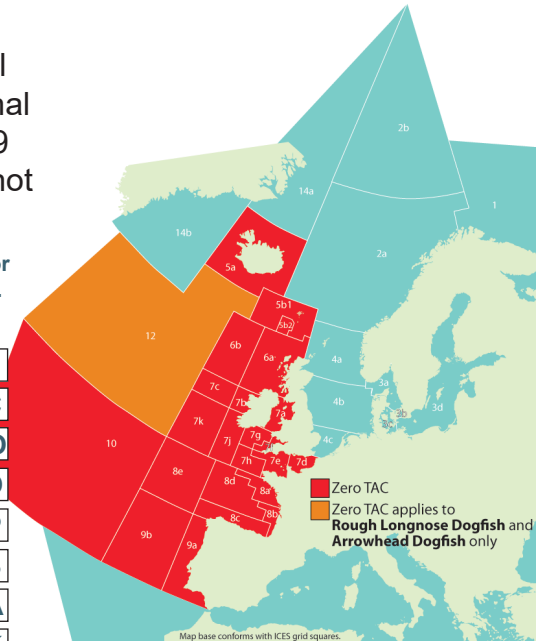


A ZERO-TAC has been set for all EU vessels in EU and international waters of ICES areas 5, 6, 7, 8, 9 and 10¹. The species below cannot be landed²:

A bycatch allowance is in place exclusively for longline fishery targeting Black Scabbardfish. No directed fishery is permitted.
