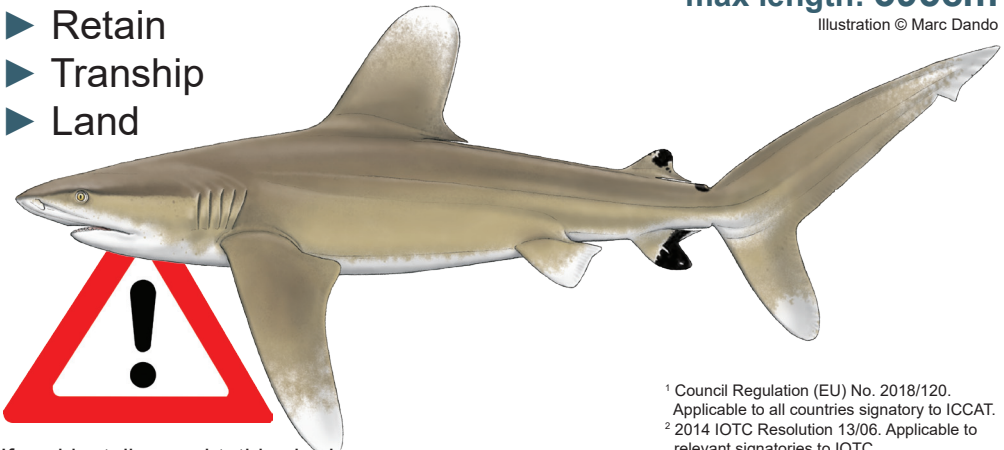


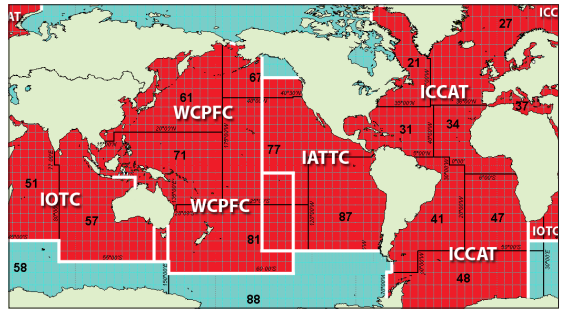
Designated a **PROHIBITED SPECIES** for all EU vessels in ICCAT¹, IOTC², IATTC³ and WCPFC⁴ convention area waters.

Within these waters it is prohibited to:

- ▶ Retain
- ▶ Tranship
- ▶ Land



If accidentally caught, this shark shall not be harmed. Specimens shall be promptly released, with details recorded in vessel logbook.⁵
