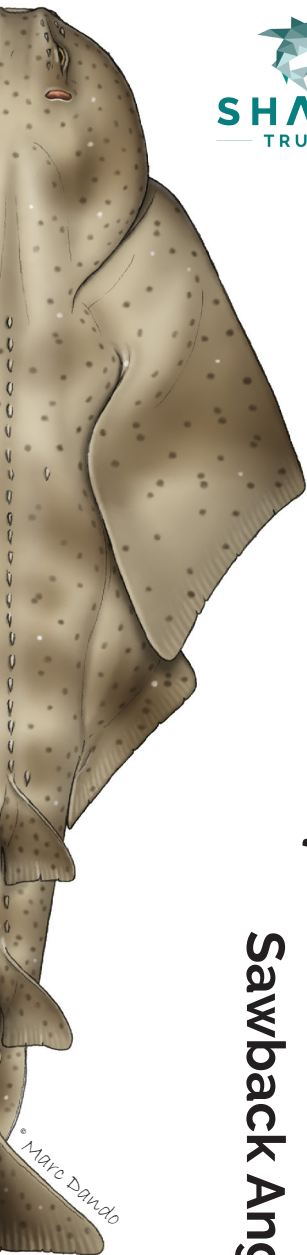




Squatina acculeata Sawback Angelshark

Range: Eastern Atlantic (West Africa) & Med.

Max length: 188cm

Caught: by target fisheries & as bycatch

Status: Critically Endangered

As large flat-bodied coastal species, angelsharks are highly vulnerable to fishing pressure. Abundance has declined rapidly over the past 50 years.
